



# FINDING SAFETY AND SUPPORT WITH MY SISTER'S PLACE

As one of DC's first domestic violence shelters, My Sister's Place (MSP), has been serving survivors of domestic violence in DC for 45 years.



## OUR PROGRAMS

### SAFE HOUSING

- Sanctuary Plus and Sanctuary II: short-term **emergency housing** in dormitory-style or apartment-style units.
- RISE and Rise Plus: 1 to 2-year **transitional housing**, where families have the option to remain in their homes post-program

### SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR CLIENTS IN OUR HOUSING PROGRAMS

- **1:1 Case Management:** individualized, ongoing support, advocacy, and referrals
- Fresh Start Fund: **cash assistance** for emergency needs or education and employment opportunities
- **Workforce Development** Program: in-house training and wrap-around services for employment and career development.
- **Children's Programs:** support for children to develop healthy behaviors through various activities.
- **Aftercare:** Ongoing support for clients after exiting our housing programs.
