OUR PROGRAMS

SAFE HOUSING

- Sanctuary Plus and Sanctuary II: short-term
 emergency housing in dormitory-style or apartment-style units.
- RISE and Rise Plus: 1 to 2-year transitional housing, where families have the option to remain in their homes post-program

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR CLIENTS IN OUR HOUSING PROGRAMS

- 1:1 Case Management: individualized, ongoing support, advocacy, and referrals
- Fresh Start Fund: **cash assistance** for emergency needs or education and employment opportunities
- Workforce Development Program: in-house training and wrap-around services for employment and career development.
- Children's Programs: support for children to develop healthy behaviors through various activities.
- Aftercare: Ongoing support for clients after exiting our housing programs.
